J U D G M E N T

Petitioner, who is aggrieved by Ext.P2 order awarding him punishment of compulsory retirement, has filed Ext.P3 appeal dated 14.07.2017, before the 3rd respondent.

2. Petitioner challenges Ext.P2 order and seeks a direction to the 3rd respondent to pass orders on the statutory appeal, Ext.P3.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel.

In view of the above circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of, directing the 3rd respondent to consider and pass orders on Ext.P3 appeal, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 'two months' from the date of receipt of a copy of the judgment.
