Corpus Petition to that effect. Hence, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

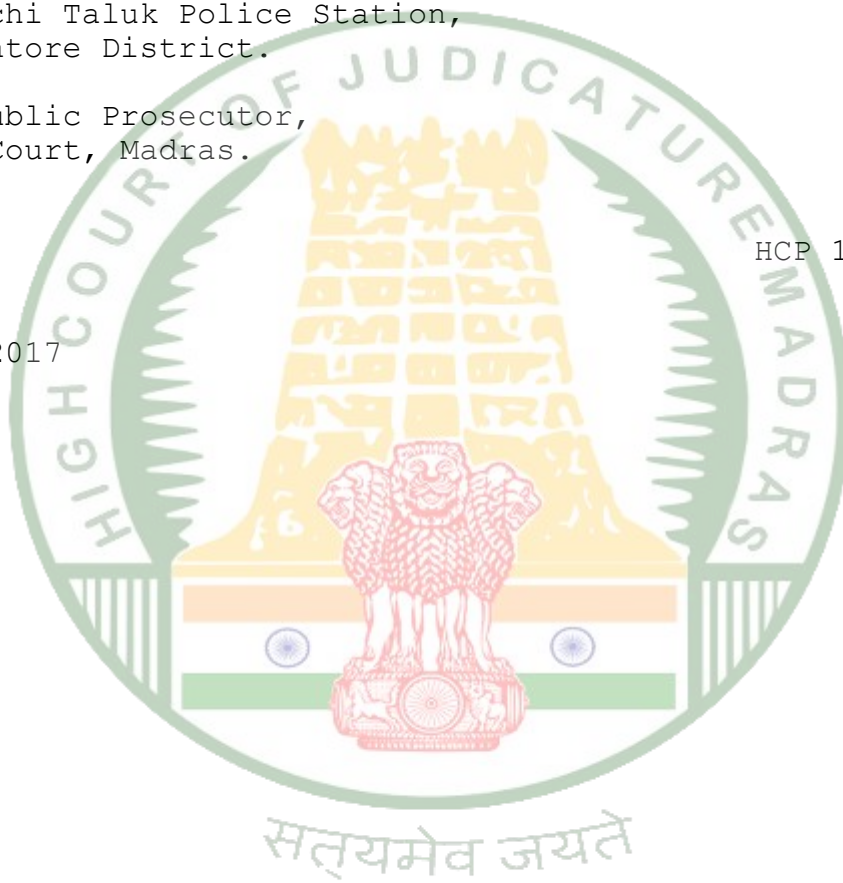
