in the petition has become infructuous.

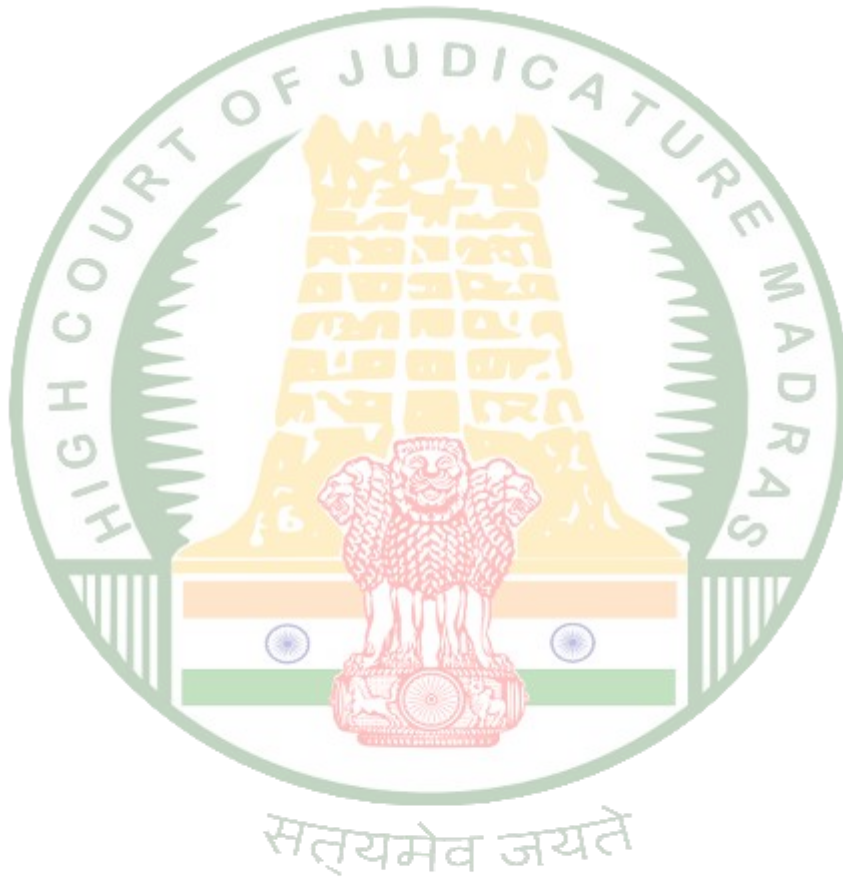
4. In fine, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.

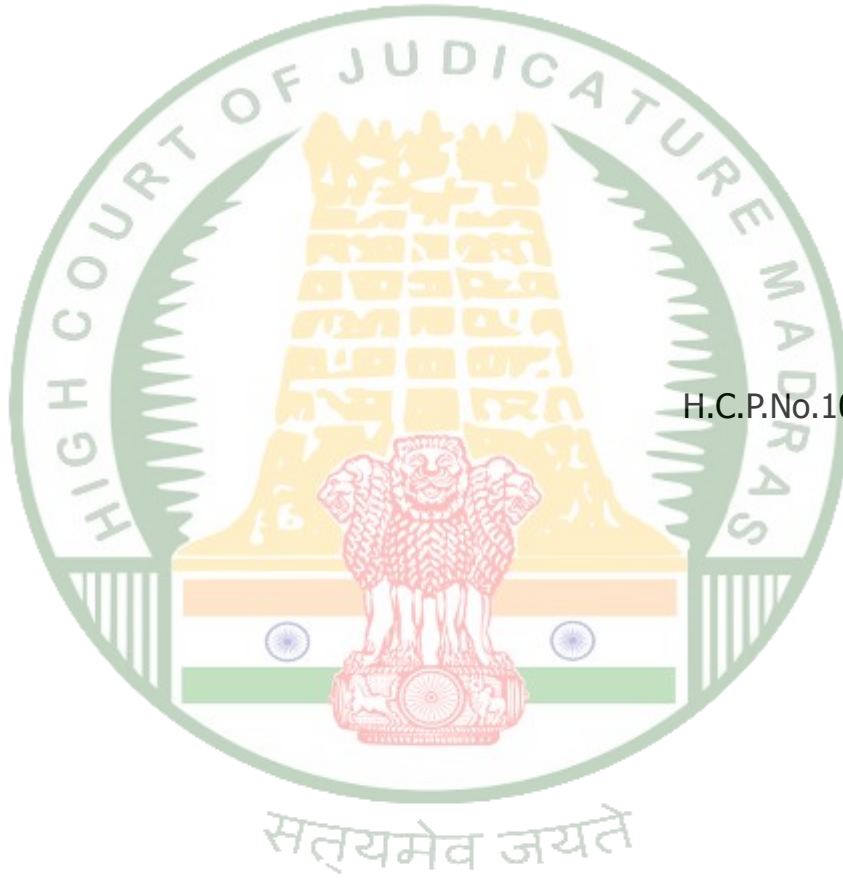
