3 Considering the limited scope of the relief sought by the petitioner, this Court, without going into the merits of the case, directs the first respondent to consider and pass orders on the representation dated 10.04.2017 submitted by the petitioner in this regard, in the light of the aforementioned Government Order as well as the order dated 18.03.2016 passed by the Division Bench of this Court, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

This writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction. Costs made easy.
