This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to call for the records relating to the detention order passed in 297/BCDFGISSSV/2017 dated 24.05.2017 by the Detaining Authority against the detenu by name, Manikandan @ Kurangu Mani, aged 25 years, S/o.Muniyappan, residing at No.131, 11th Street, Annai Sivagami Nagar, Ennore, Chennai-57 and quash the same.

2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has submitted to the effect that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked by virtue of G.O.Rt.No.3232 dated 03.07.2017 and a copy of the same is submitted, wherein, it is clearly stated that the Detention Order in question has been revoked.

3. Considering the above said factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

4. In fine, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.

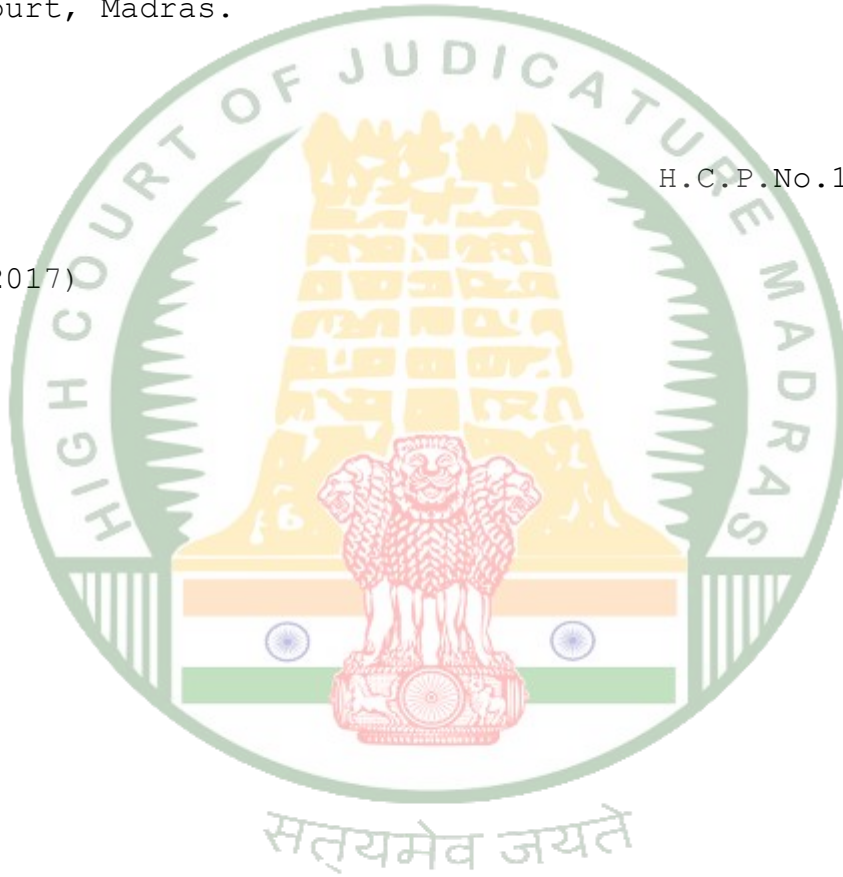
