This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to trace out and produce the detainee, by name, Hemalatha, aged 21 years, wife of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is present and he has been identified by his counsel.

3. The second respondent, viz., the Inspector of Police, C-2 Elephant Gate Police Station, has produced the detainee and she has been identified by the petitioner.

4. Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
