dated 22.06.2017 by the Detaining Authority against the detenu by name, Jamal Basha, aged 52 years, S/o.Masthan Sahib, No.3-5-150/2, 4th Street, Rajagopalapuram, Nayudupet, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh, and quash the same.

2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has represented that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked, by virtue of G.O.Rt.No.221 dated 04.08.2017 and a copy of the same is submitted, wherein, it is clearly stated that the Detention Order in question has been revoked.

3. Considering the above said factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

4. In fine, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.
