Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.K.P.SATHISH KUMAR Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.T.M.PAPPIAH Special Government Pleader for 1, 4 & 6 respondents and MR.S.SEETHALAKSHMI Advocate for 2nd respondent and MR.P.R.GOPINATHAN Advocate for 3rd respondent and MR. on behalf of the Respondents the court made the following order:-
