This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant/Transport Corporation Mr.M.Sivakumar and the learned counsel for the respondent Mr.K.J.Sivakumar are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The claimants have filed this appeal, challenging the Award passed for a sum of Rs.8,54,928/- along with interest at 7.5% p.a from the date of petition till the date of deposit, which was awarded to the appellants herein.

2. Now, both the parties have agreed to settle the issue for a total compensation of a sum of Rs.11,75,000/- in full quit.

3. Therefore, as per the settlement arrived at between the parties, there shall be an award for a sum of Rs.11,75,000/- (Rupees eleven lakhs seventy five thousand only), which shall be deposited by the Transport Corporation, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
