ORDER

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to direct the respondents 1 and 2, to trace out and produce the detainee, by name, Santhiya, aged 19 years, daughter of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is not present, whereas, his counsel is present.

3. The second respondent, viz., The Inspector of Police, Sriperumbudur Police Station, Kanchipuram, has produced the alleged detainee. Since the petitioner is not present, identification of the petitioner cannot be made. Under such circumstances, this petition deserves to be dismissed.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.

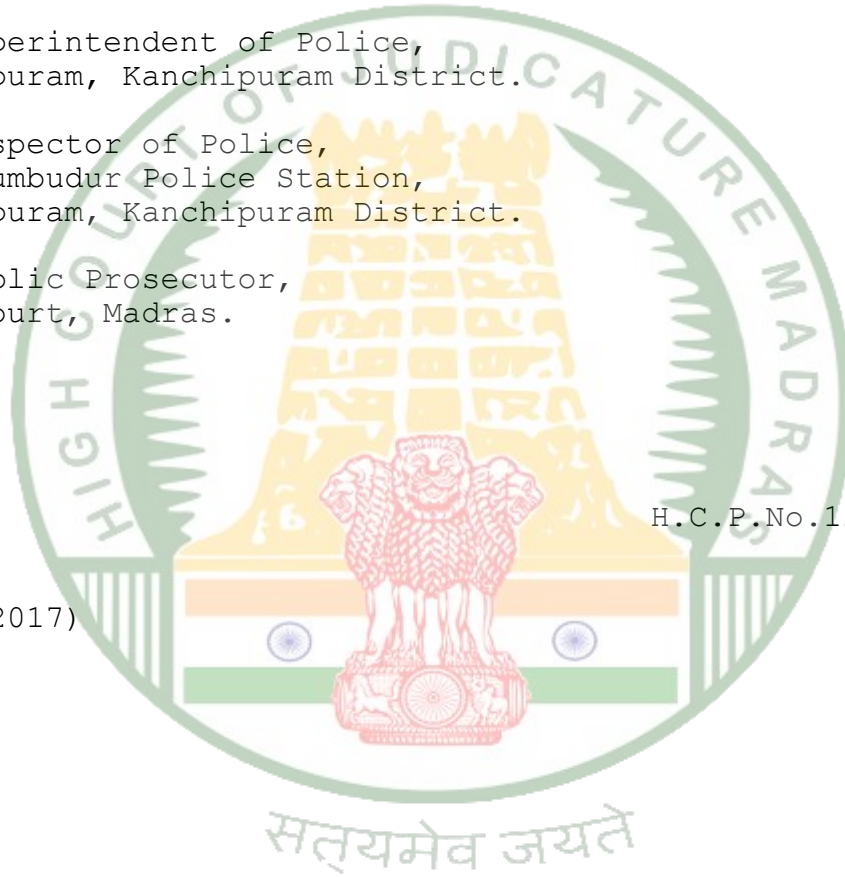
