2. The petitioner is present and he has been identified by his counsel.

3.The second respondent, viz., The Inspector of Police, V.3 JJ Nagar Police Station, Anna Nagar, Chennai, has produced the detainee and she has been identified by the petitioner/her father. The detainee has expressed her willingness to go with the petitioner/her father.

4.Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
