ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by A.SELVAM,J.)

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to trace out and produce the detainee, by name, Indu Mangai, aged 17 years, daughter of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is present and he has been identified by his counsel.

3.The second respondent, viz., the Inspector of Police, Thalaivasal Police Station, Salem District, has produced the detainee and she has been identified by the petitioner/her father.

4.It is seen from the records that the date of birth of the detainee is 07.08.1999 and now she has attained majority.

5.Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
