Till such time, there shall be an order of status quo qua a portion of the impugned order.

2. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

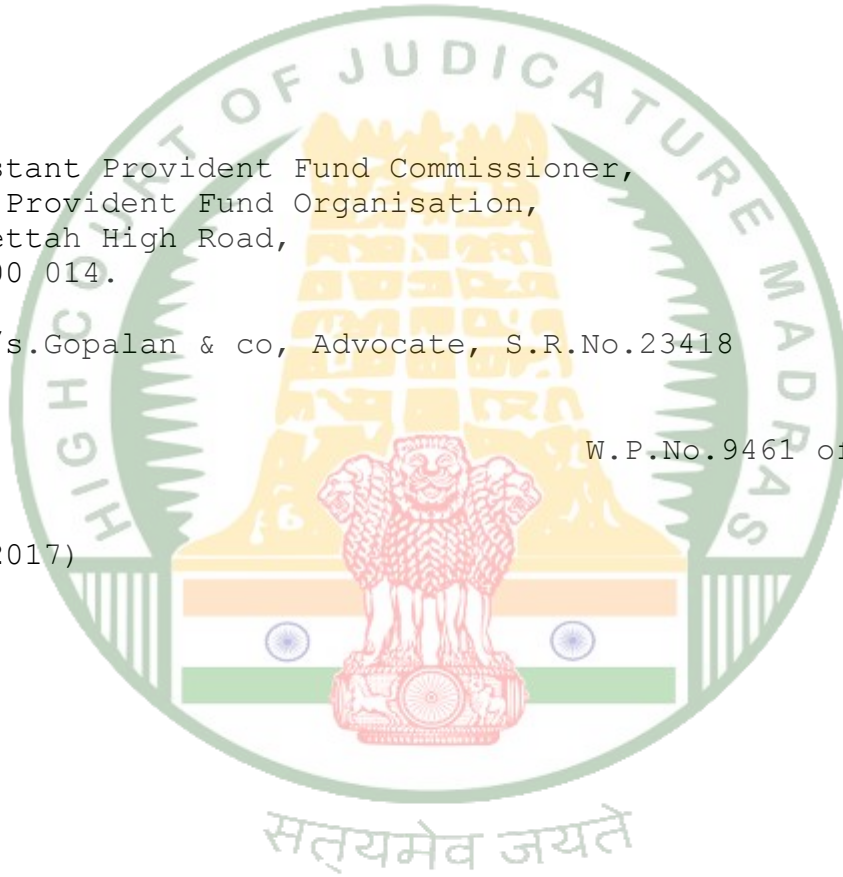
