ORDER

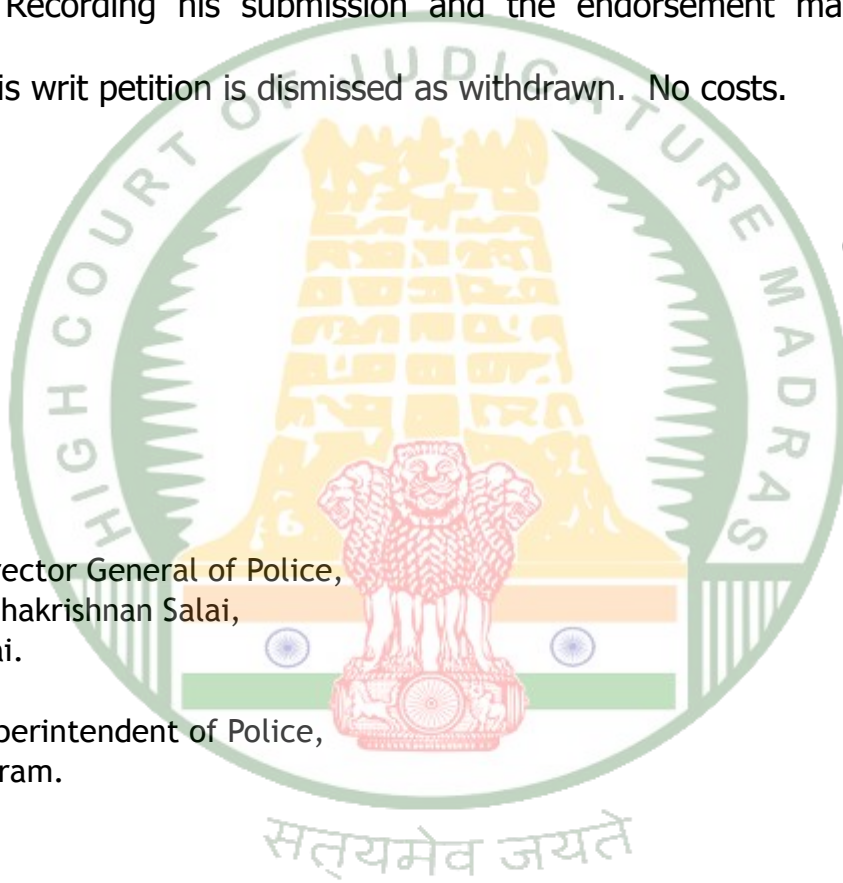

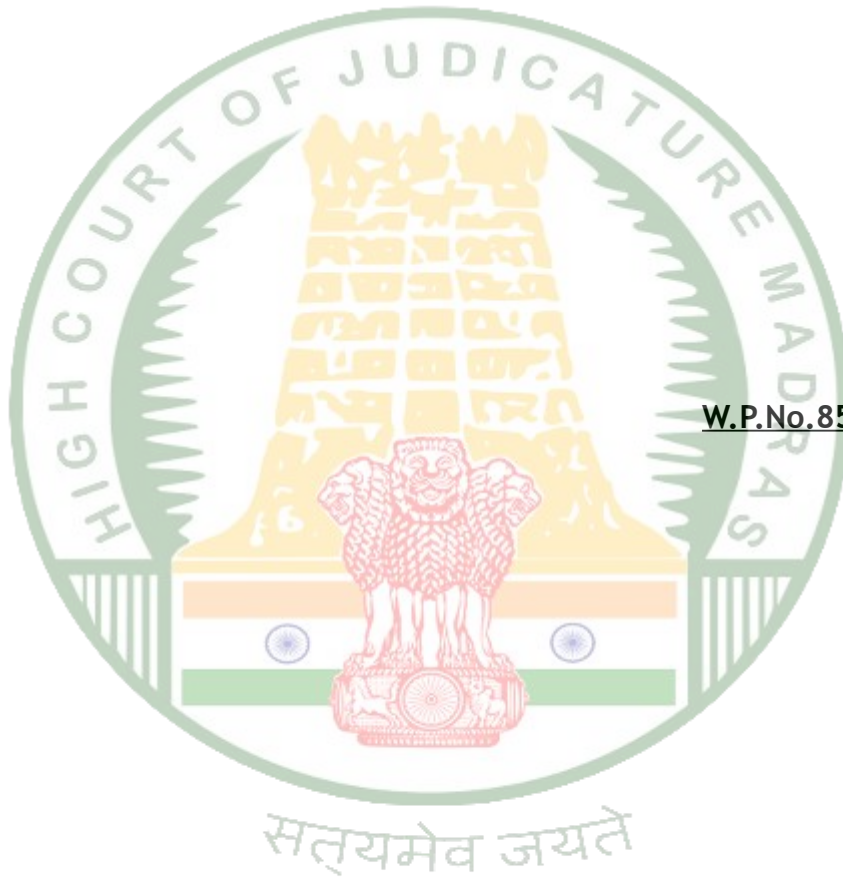
