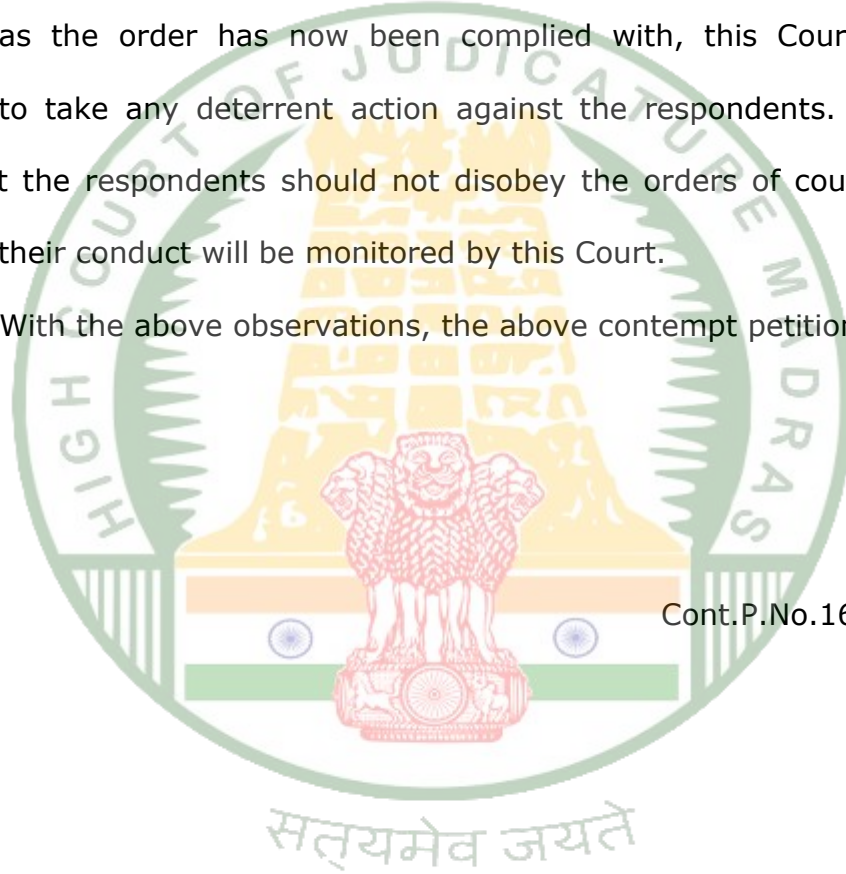
2. The learned Additional Government Pleader submits that there is no willful disobedience of the order and that on account of administrative issues, the matter got delayed.
