Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying to direct the Learned Special Judge / Principal Sessions Judge, Villupuram District to consider the Bail petition filed by the petitioners' in connection with Cr.No.160 of 2017 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Vanur Police Station, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District.

O R D E R

The petitioners seek for a direction to the learned Special Judge / Principal Sessions Judge, Villupuram District to consider the bail petition filed by the petitioners on bail, on the same day in the event of their surrender and filing bail application in Cr.No.160 of 2017 pending investigation on the file of the respondent police.

2.The petitioners are accused for offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 324, 506(2), 3(1)(X) of the Scheduled Castes and The Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

3. Heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the materials available on record.

4. Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and that taking into custody of the petitioners pending consideration of their bail application could cause them irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct petitioners to surrender within a period of ten days from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order. The learned Special Judge / Principal Sessions Judge, Villupuram District is also directed to consider the bail application of the petitioners on merits and pass appropriate order on the same day of their surrender, if the offences mentioned in this order is present in that petitions.

5. The petition is ordered accordingly.
