Hence, recording the statements made by the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre as well as the terms entered in the Memo of Compromise, dated 10.06.2017, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed. Consequently, the investigation in Crime No. 19 of 2016, dated 07.11.2016, pending on the file of respondent police is quashed.

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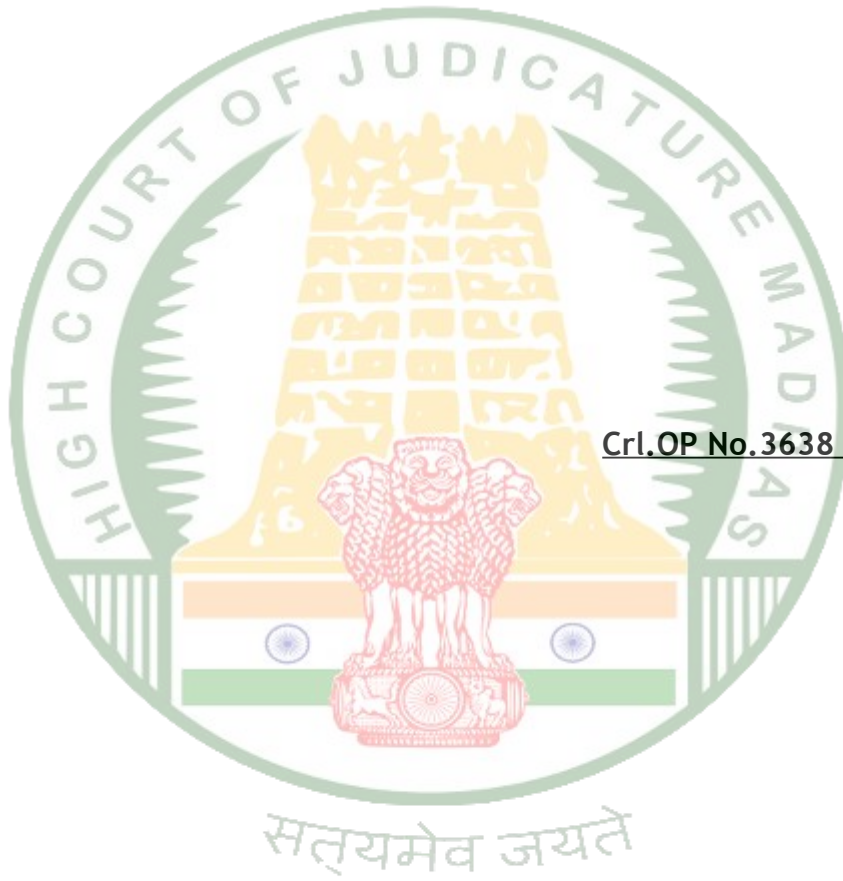
