2.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are in Mumbai and are being unnecessarily harassed by the respondent police based on the complaint given by the de facto complainant, under the guise of enquiry. In the mean while, since the conciliation proceedings are going to commence on 18.04.2017, the learned counsel for the petitioners seek appropriate direction.

3.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the respondent police is directed not to harass the petitioners. Post on 05.06.2017.
