3.The first respondent, viz., the Inspector of Police, Town Police Station, Krishnagiri District, has produced the detainee and she has been identified by the petitioner/her father.

4.Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.

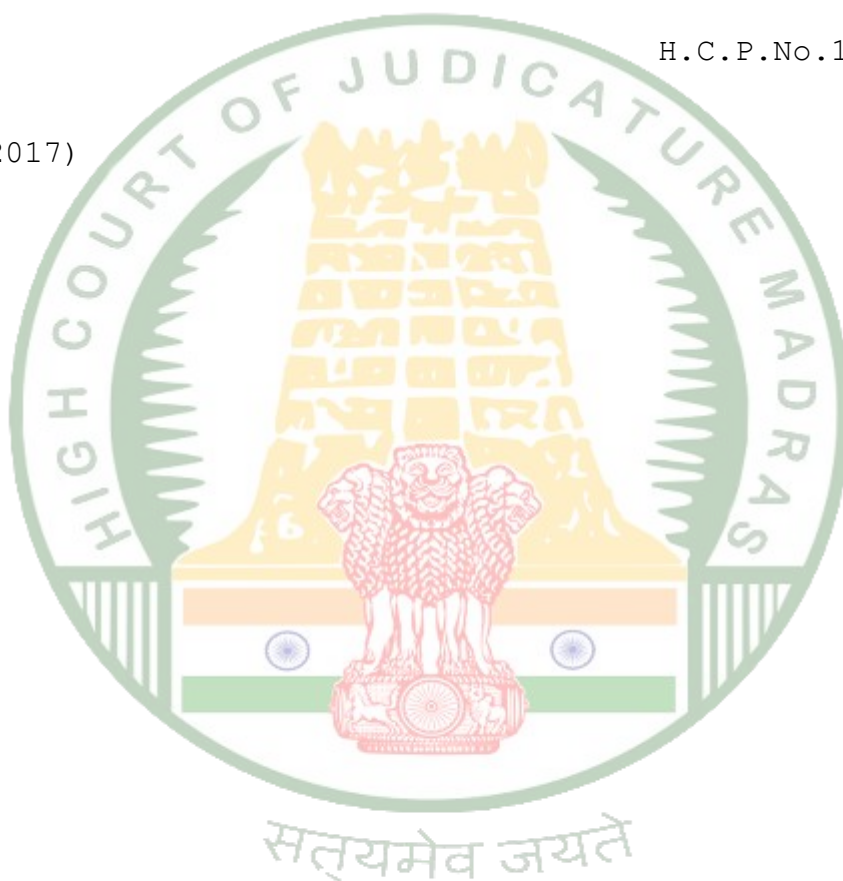
