ORDER

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, seeks permission of this Court, to withdraw this writ petition, with a liberty to work out his remedy opened to him under law, in the light of the common order dated 30.09.2015 made in WP.No.18397/2014 etc., batch and also made an endorsement in the writ petition to that effect.

2 The Court heard the submissions of Mr.A.N.Thambidurai, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 ; Mr.Master Ganesh, learned counsel appearing for the 5th respondent and Mr.A.Nagarajan, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the 6th respondent and also perused the counter affidavit filed by the 4th respondent.

3 In the light of the endorsement made, the writ petition stands dismissed. Liberty sought for by the petitioner, is granted. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is also dismissed.
