O R D E R

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings in FIR No.5 of 2017 pending on the file of the first respondent police.

2.When this Criminal Original Petition was taken up, the second respondent / de facto complainant appeared before this Court and filed an affidavit in which it is stated that the complaint given by her to the first respondent police was based on the false information given by her relatives. 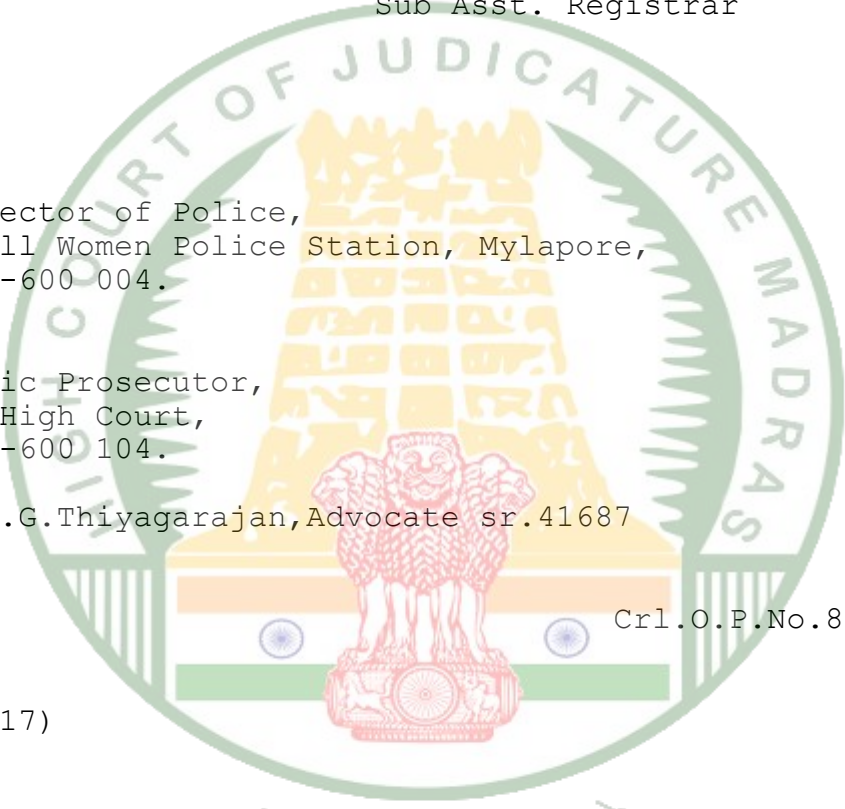
