4.Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.

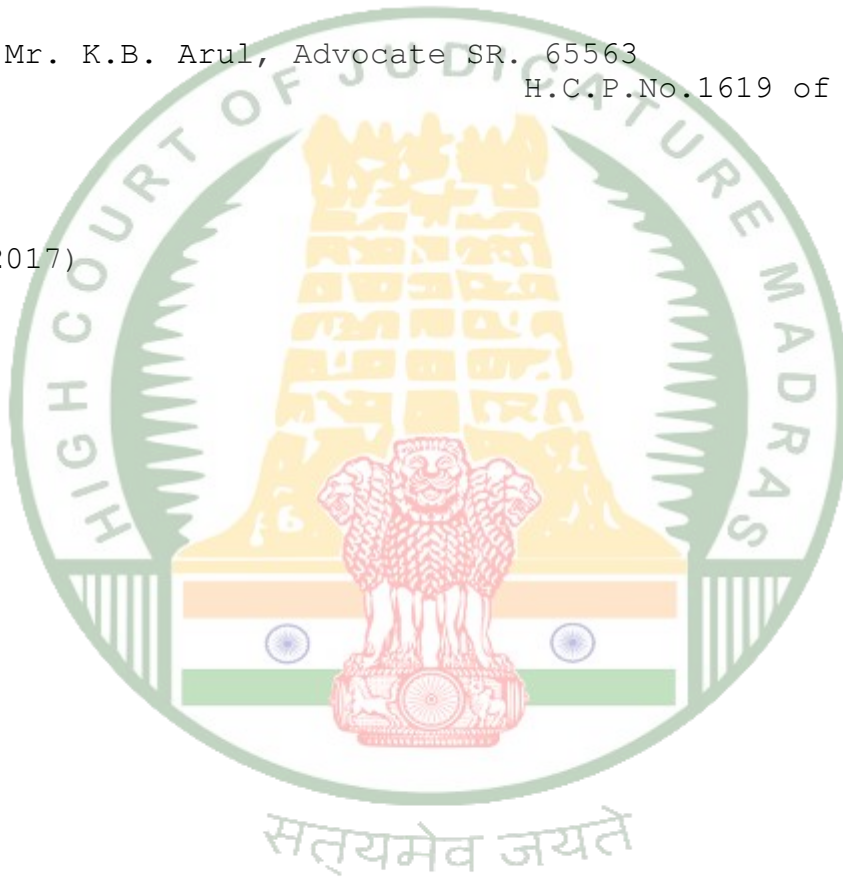
