It is the case of the petitioner that based on the complaint given by the petitioner, a case was registered in Crime No.168 of 2017 for an offence under Sections 147, 148, 294 (b), 323, 420 and 506(ii) IPC and Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Woman Act, 2002 on 11.04.2017 and thereafter, there is no progress in the investigation. 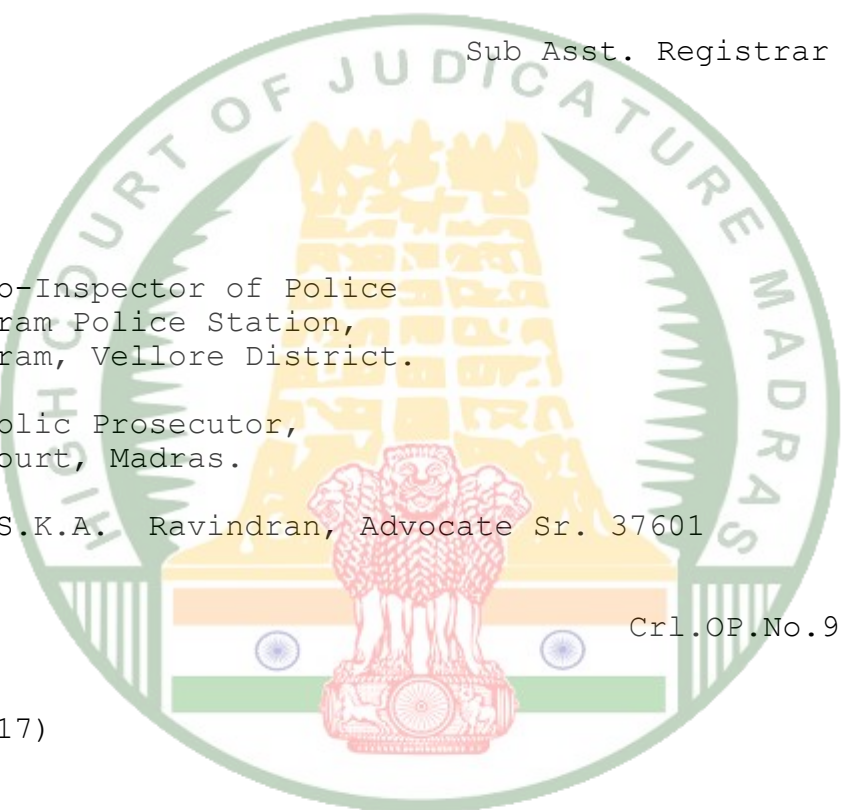
