By way of filing this writ petition, the petitioner seeks to quash the impugned Government Order passed in G.O.Ms.No.199, School Education (ii) Department, dated 17.09.2008, in and by which, the first respondent recalled the G.O.Ms.No.837, dated 04.05.1976, granting five years of extension of service to the Retired National Awardee Teachers.

After some arguments, it is stated by the learned Additional Advocate General for the respondents that till date, no National Award was granted to the Teachers, therefore, the Government have resolved to recall the said G.O.Ms.No.837, dated 04.05.1976, granting five years of extension of services to the retired National Awardee Teachers.

3. It is at this stage, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner sought for a limited prayer of a direction to the respondent to consider the pending representation dated 17.03.2017 of the petitioner.

4. Therefore, this Court, without going into the merits of the matter, directs the first respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on the pending representation dated 17.03.2017 of the petitioner on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. With this direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No Costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

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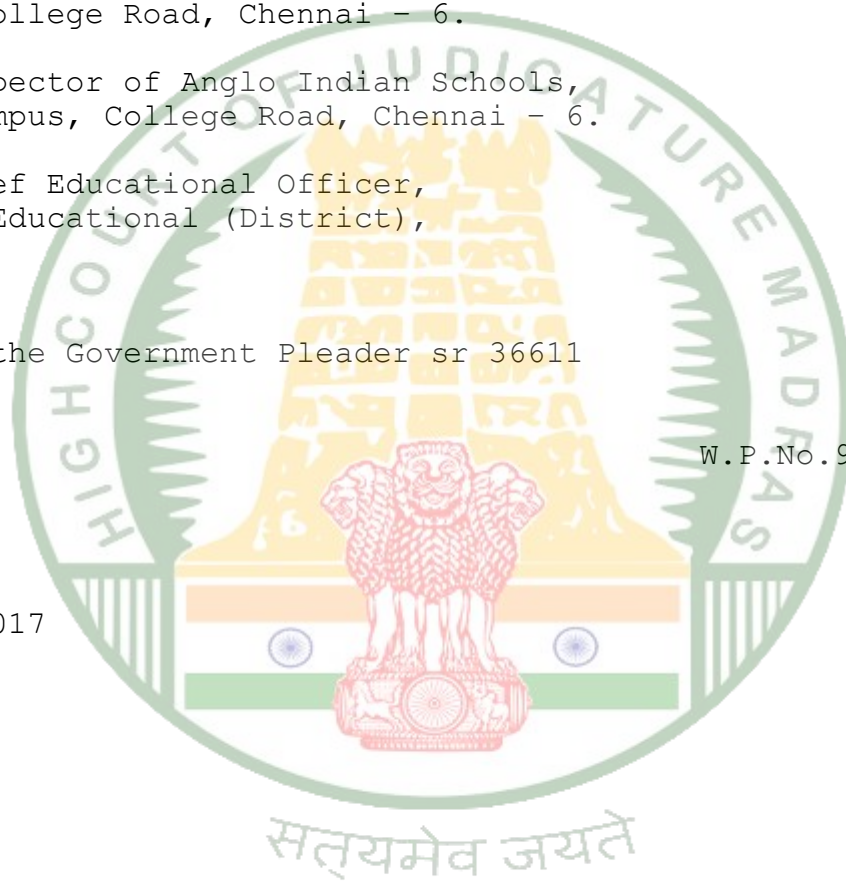
