PETITION FOR BAIL 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A-6, was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 26.03.2017 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 364[A], 395 r/w 397 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.61 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with others abducted the de facto complainant demanding ransom and thus, committed the above said offences.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person, he has been falsely implicated as an accused in the present case and that he is a permanent residence, the co-accused has already been released on bail and therefore, he may be released on bail.

4. Learned Government Advocate [Crl. Side] opposed this petition contending that the investigation is yet to be completed. However, he concedes that the co-accused has been released on bail.

5. Considering the duration of custody of the petitioner from 26.03.2017, that the co-accused has been already released on bail, the fact that the petitioner is having permanent residence and also the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is

inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- [Rupees Ten Thousand only] with two sureties each for a like sum, to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate-II, Udumalpet and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., for a period of two months.
