ORDER

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal. Mr.P.Sanjai Gandhi, learned Additional Government Pleader accepts notice for 1st and 3rd respondents and

Mr.G.Anantharangan, learned Standing counsel accepts notice on behalf of the 2nd respondent.

2. The petitioner, while employed as Junior Engineer in the service of the 2nd respondent was visited with disciplinary proceedings in TDP No.19 of 2012 and though the proceedings have been concluded, so far no orders have been passed. It is further submitted that the petitioner was also issued with a charge memo by the 2nd respondent vide proceedings dated 12.08.2015 and the charges framed against the petitioner came to be dropped.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that though enquiry proceedings are over before the 3rd respondent, the result of the said proceedings is yet to be made known to the petitioner and as a consequence, he is deprived of the service and other benefits and therefore, came forward to file this writ petition.

4. Heard the submission of Mr.P.Sanjai Gandhi, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for 1st and 3rd respondents and Mr.G.Anantharangan, learned Standing counsel for the 2nd respondent.

5. This Court, taking into consideration, the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, directs the **(*)2nd** respondent to pass final orders in disciplinary proceedings **(**)initiated against the petitioner** in TDP case No.19 of 2012 on merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible and not later than ten weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken to the petitioner. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
