3. The petitioner seeks for a mandamus directing the respondents to consider his representation dated 30.10.2017, wherein and whereby he sought for granting crop insurance to his

agricultural land, which is covered under Pradhan Matri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) scheme for the year 2016-2017.

4. The grievance of the petitioner before this Court, is that the said request has not been considered so far. This Court, at this stage, is not expressing any view on the claim made by the petitioner, as it is for the first respondent to consider and decide the same. Thus, this writ petition is disposed of, only with a direction to the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 30.10.2017 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, after giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. Such exercise shall be done by the first respondent within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
