O R D E R

(Order of the Court was made by RAJIV SHAKDHER, J)

1. The detainee Ms.Jayashree has been produced in Court. We are told that she is 19 years of age. We have interacted with the detainee/Ms.Jayashree. She says that she has married the son of the petitioner, one Mr.Aravindkumar.

2. Respondent No.2 is the father of the detainee, while respondent No.3 is the paternal uncle of the detainee. Mr.Jayaprakash, Advocate appeared for respondent Nos.2 and 3.

The learned counsel says that since the detainee/Ms.Jayashree wishes to remain in the company of Mr.Aravindkumar, he has no objection to the same.

3. Hence, no further orders are called for in the petition. The detainee, being major, she is entitled to take a decision concerning her own life. Accordingly, consign the petition to record.
