3. Civil Revision Petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

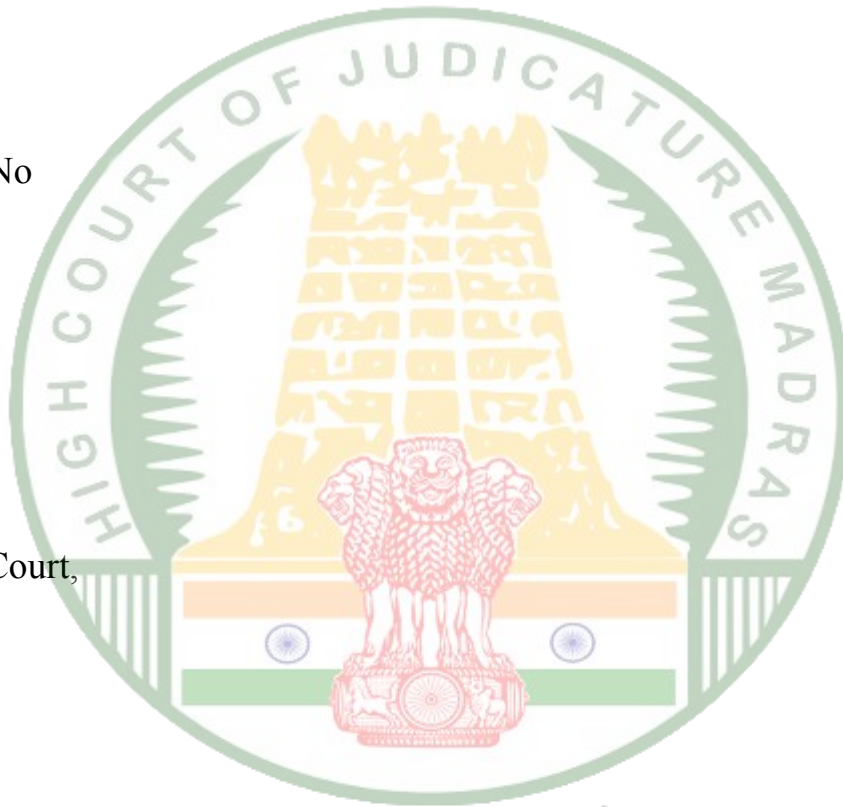
