The writ petition has been filed to forbear the respondents particularly the District Manager Tasmac Retail Vending Shops, TASMAC, Villupuram District, The District Collector, Villupuram District, The Superintendent of Police, Villupuram the respondents 3 to 5 from running the Tasmac shop No.11569 in the residential house of the 7th respondent
