c) Direct payment of costs of this petition from and out of the assets of the respondent Company in liquidation.

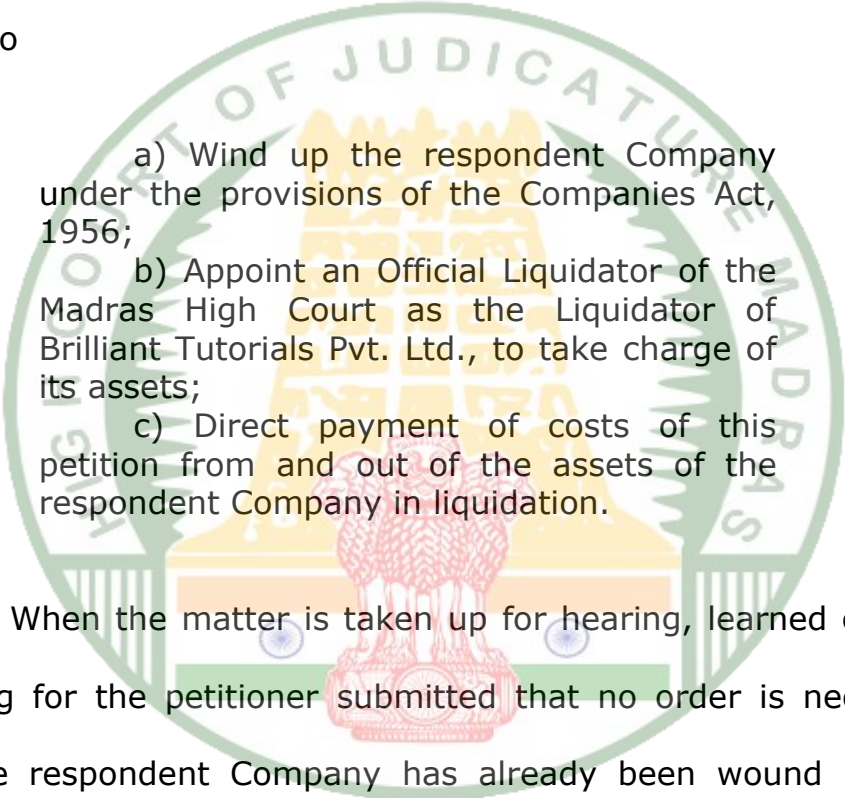
