4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the third respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 23.01.2017 with regard to giving permission for Aadal Padal Programme, and pass orders only on merits and in accordance with law. This Court is not granting any positive direction as far as Aadal Padal programme is concerned.
