Registry is directed to return the original papers to learned counsel for petitioner.

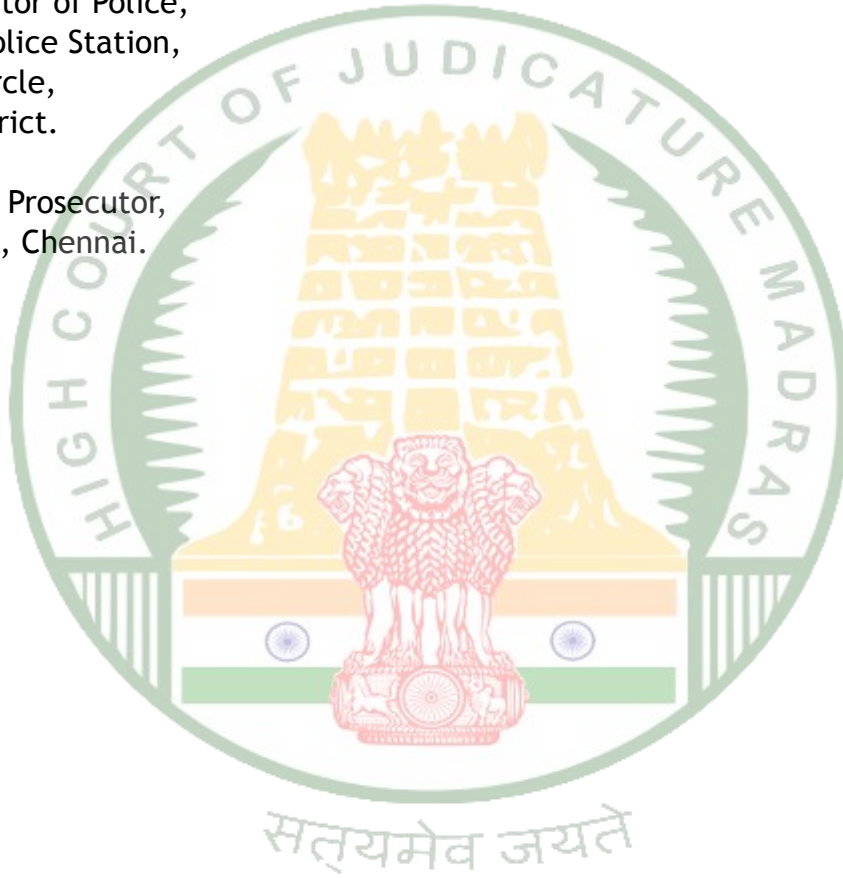
