Alleging that the petitioner's wife Mrs.Jayalakshmi, aged about 29 years has been found missing from 19.01.2017. Since, the detinue was so far not secured by the respondent Police, the petitioner is before this Court with this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2.Today, both the petitioner and the detinue have appeared before this Court. The detinue has returned to home and now expressed her willingness to live with the petitioner. The same

is recorded. Thus, nothing survives in this petition.
Accordingly, the Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed.

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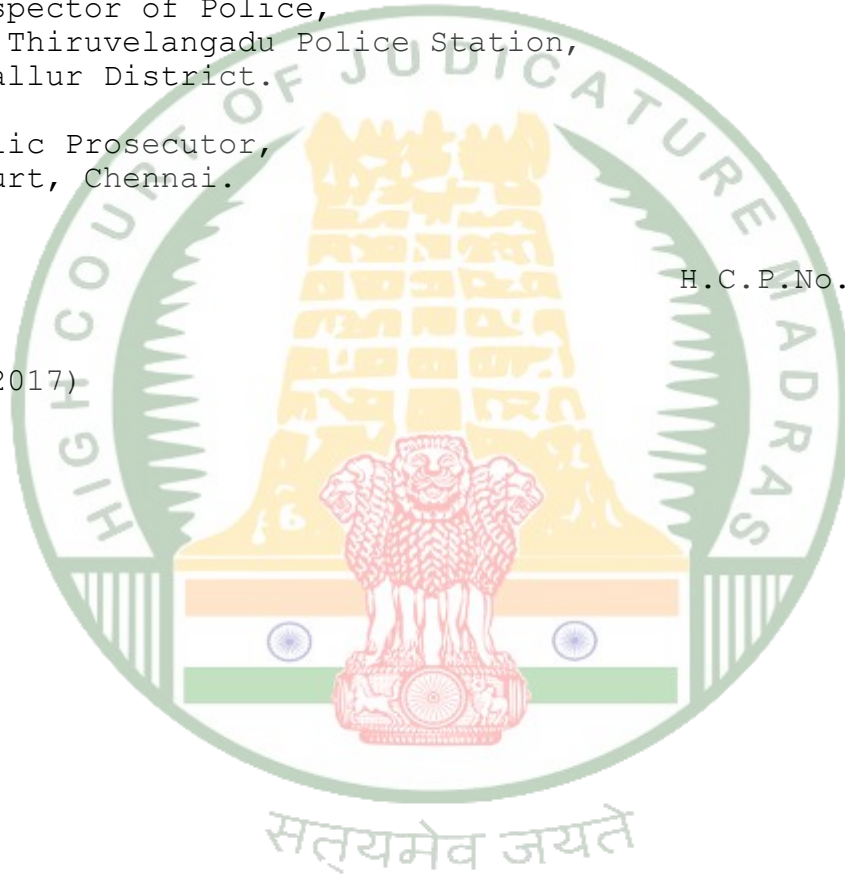
