The petitioner is the wife of the 3rd respondent. They have got two children viz., Minor.Manisha, aged about 8 years and Minor.Srisivaram, aged about 5 years. Now, the children are in the custody of the 3rd respondent. With that allegation, the petitioner has come up with this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. In our considered view, it is not an illegal detention. If the petitioner claims, that she has got the right to take the children, she can work out her remedy before the appropriate forum. Therefore, we are unable to grant any relief sought by the petitioner. Hence the Habeas Corpus petition is dismissed.
