The relief sought for in the writ petition is to direct the respondents 1 to 3 to appoint the writ petitioner as P.G. Assistant Teacher (Commerce) in the 4th respondent's School.

2 However, the present miscellaneous petition is filed seeking interim injunction restraining the respondents 1 to 3 from approving the appointment of the 5th respondent as P.G. Assistant Teacher (Commerce).

3 This Court is of the view that the rights of the respective parties shall be adjudicated at the time of final hearing of the writ petition and any order passed in this regard will be subject to the result of the final orders to be passed in this writ petition.

4 Accordingly, no further orders in respect of interim injunction is required and the miscellaneous petition stands disposed of.
