ORDER

Challenging the order dated 12.02.2015 made by the learned Judicial Magistrate, in M.C.No.4 of 2013 dismissing the application filed by the wife under Section 125 of Cr.P.C. against her husband for maintenance allowance, the present criminal revision case has been filed by her.

The parties have also filed a joint memo of compromise to that effect.

3. In the result, this criminal revision case is closed recording the joint memo of compromise filed by the parties. The joint memo of compromise shall form part of this order.
