Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to disburse the payments relating to Gratuity, Pension Commutation, Leave encashment, Earn Leave, pension arrears and settlement arrears amount from 01.09.2013 by calculating Dearness Allowance eligible as per newly implemented scheme, with interest at 12% per annum with effect from 01.09.2013 within the stipulated time as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

ORDER

The petitioner, after joining the respondent-Corporation as Driver, retired from service on 30.06.2016 in the post of Selection Grade Driver on superannuation. His grievance is that his retirement benefits, namely, Gratuity, Pension Commutation,

Leave encashment, Applicable Dearness Allowance, pension arrears and settlement arrears amount, 12(3) settlement arrears and all other attendant benefits by calculating D.A.eligible as per newly implemented scheme have not been till date settled. Therefore, he has come to this Court seeking a direction to the respondents to settle the aforementioned retirement benefits with interest at 12% per annum with effect from 01.09.2013 within the stipulated time as fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

2. Mr.P.Kannankumar, learned standing counsel for the Transport Corporation submitted that since there has been a direction issued by the Hon'ble Division Bench in W.A.(MD) Nos.383 to 457 of 2015 dated 12.6.2015 directing the Corporation to disburse all the retiral benefits in twelve equal monthly instalments with 6% interest per annum, a similar direction may be issued in this writ petition also.

3. This Court, recording the statement made by the learned standing counsel for the respondents, taking note of the Hon'ble Division Bench judgment in W.A.(MD) Nos.383 to 457 of 2015 dated 12.6.2015 (K.Rajendran and others v. The Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (Madurai) Limited represented by its Managing Director, Madurai and others) directing the respondents to settle all the retirement benefits in twelve equal monthly instalments with 6% interest per annum, hereby directs the respondents to settle the afore mentioned retirement benefits due and payable to the petitioner through twelve equal monthly instalments carrying interest of 6% p.a. The instalments should commence from July, 2017 and each of the instalments should be paid on or before 7th of each month. In case of any delay in the payment of the instalments, the interest payable would become 18% p.a. for the delayed period apart from any other remedy which may be available to the petitioner for such non-payment of the instalments. With this direction, the writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

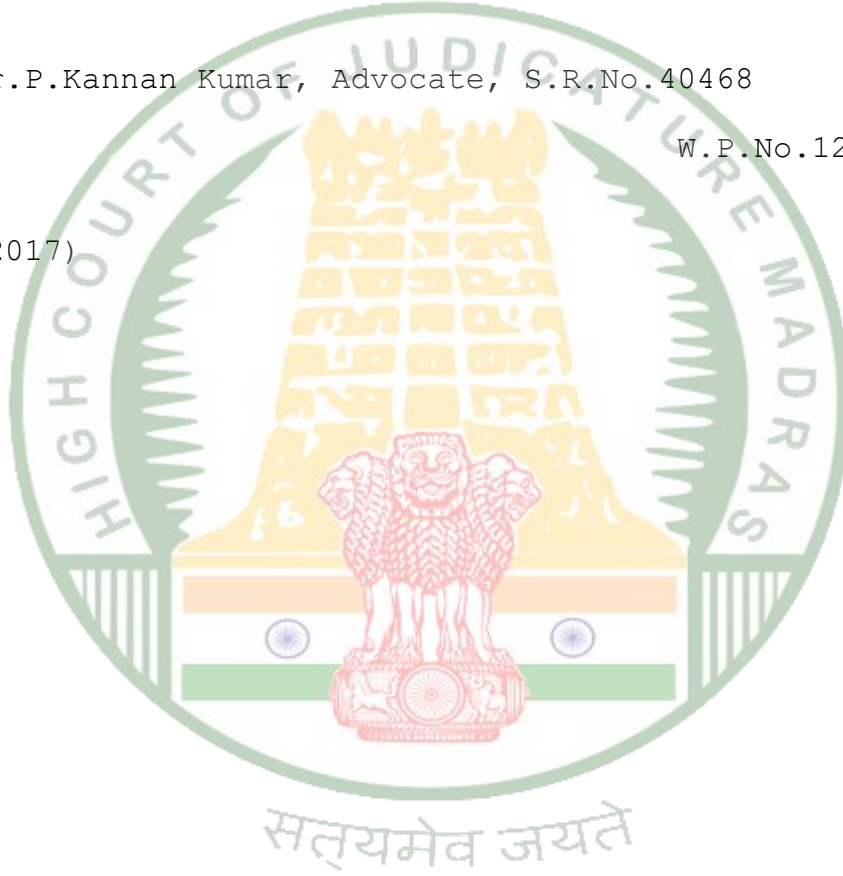
