Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked by virtue of G.O.Rt.No.113 dated 04.05.2017 and to that effect, a copy of the same has been submitted, wherein, it is clearly stated that the Detention Order in question has been revoked.
