Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS, to call for the records relating to the detention order dated 13.03.2017 passed by the second respondent in his proceedings in S.C.No.15 of 2017 and to quash the same and direct the respondents herein to produce the petitioner's son, namely Rajkumar @ Manikandan, Son of Rathinam, aged about 24 years, No.18, Kuppaimeettu Street, Oldpet, Krishnagiri and District who is presently under going detention in Central Prison, Salem under Sec. 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982) before this Court and set him at liberty forthwith.
