ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of accordingly.

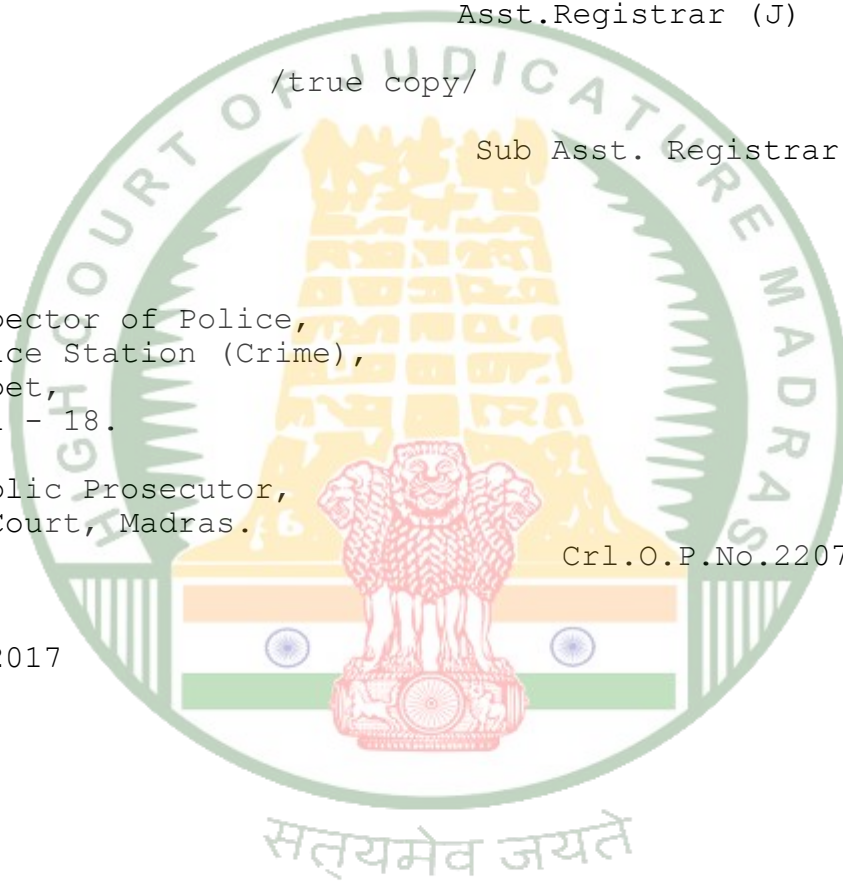
