This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to call for the records relating to the detention order passed in BCDFGISSSV No.83/2017 dated 28.03.2017 by the Detaining Authority against the detenu by name, Suresh @ Buddi Suresh, aged 26 years, S/o Peter, residing at No.33, Arputham Nagar, Kadaperi,

Thiruneermalai Road, West Tambaram, Chennai - 600 045, and quash the same.

2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has represented that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked, by virtue of G.O.Rt.No.2129 dated 02.05.2017 and a copy of the same is submitted, wherein, it is clearly stated that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked.
