O R D E R

When this Criminal Original Petition was taken up, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the second respondent, have filed a joint compromise memo dated 09.01.2017, duly signed by the petitioner, second respondent and the counsel for the petitioner, in which it is stated that the petitioner and the second respondent have now arrived at a consensus and decided to part ways decently; that the second respondent is not willing to marry the petitioner and both of them have decided to settle all their issues among
