3.The second respondent, viz., the Inspector of Police, Mohanur Police Station, Namakkal District, has produced the detainee and she has been identified by the petitioner/her mother.

4.Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine, this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
