dated 20.04.2017 by the Detaining Authority against the detenu Thaniga @ Thanikachalam, aged 31 years, S/o.Palayam, residing at No.505, Mariyamman Kovil Street, Gandhi Street, Kannigaiper (Village), Uthukkottai (Taluk), Thiruvallur District and quash the same.

2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has represented that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked, by virtue of G.O.Rt.No.2798 dated 14.06.2017 and a copy of the same is submitted, wherein, it is clearly stated that the Detention Order in question has been revoked.

3. Considering the above said factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

4. In fine, this petition is dismissed.

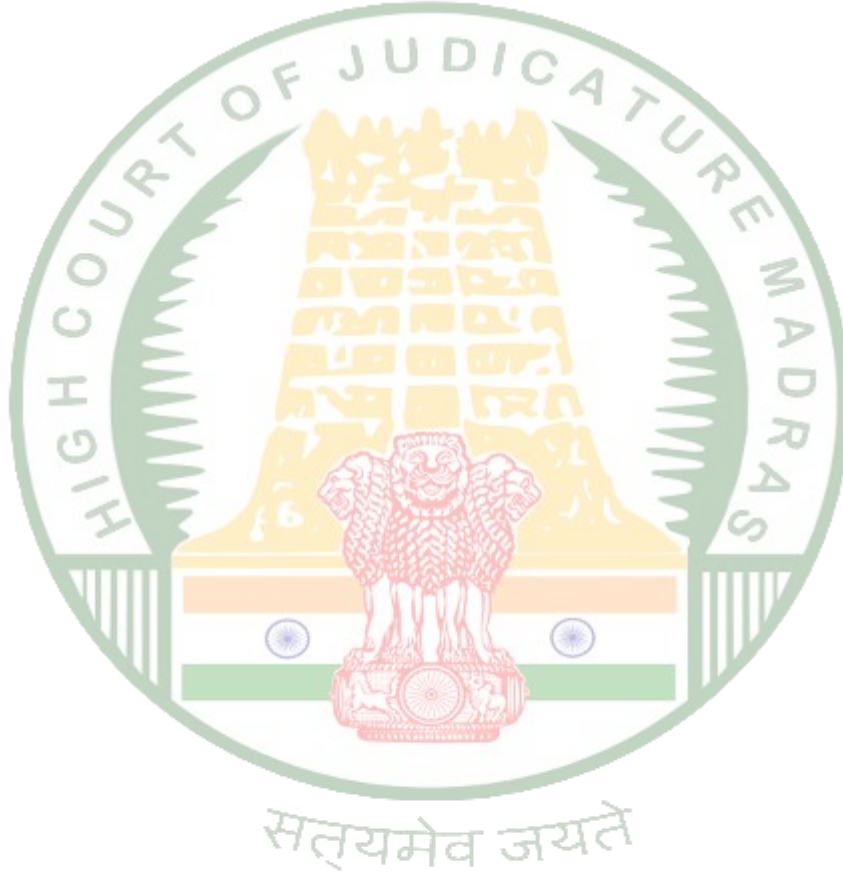
