PRAYER: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 1 to 3 to immediately register First Information Report in the case of the murder of Gopal at the hands of Respondents 4 to 7 in Melpatti Police Station under provisions

of Sections 302, 201 and other provisions of IPC, protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 and other provisions of law and consequently to direct investigation be transferred to the CB-CID under the supervision of a senior police officer no below the rank of IG of Police, award a compensation of Rs.25 lakhs.
