ORDER

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to trace out and produce the detainee, by name, A.Anitha, aged 17 years, daughter of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is present and she has been identified by her counsel.

3.The second respondent, viz., Inspector of Police, Kallakurichi Police Station, has produced the detainee and she has been identified by the petitioner/mother.

4.The detainee has expressed her willingness to go with the petitioner/mother.

5.Considering the aforesaid factual circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

In fine this habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
