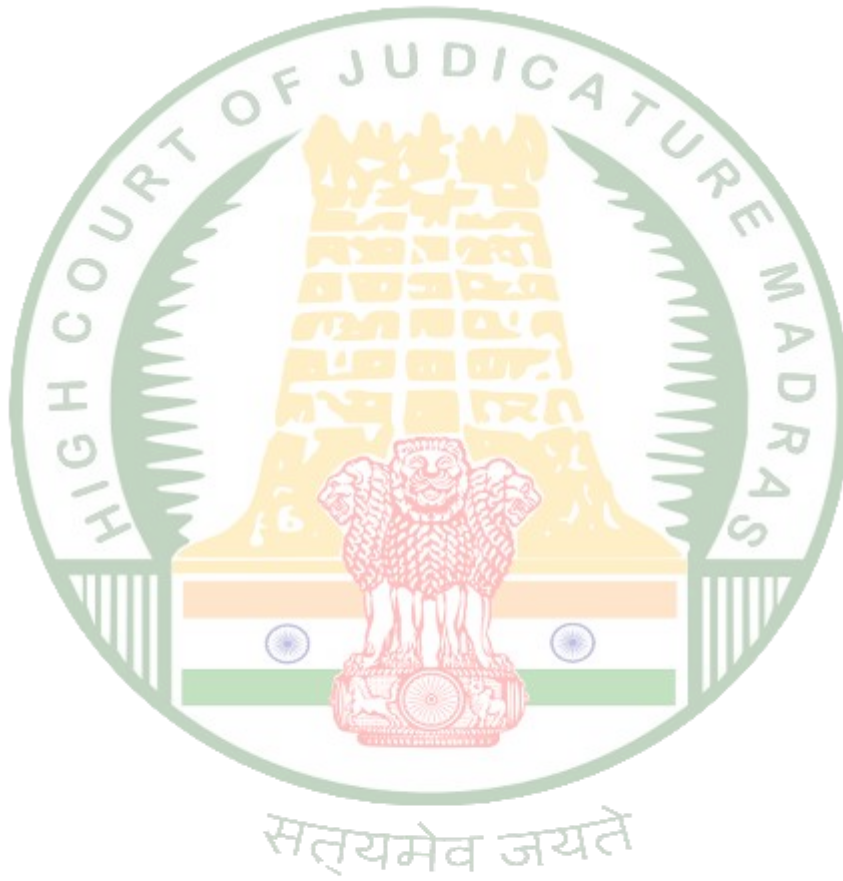
4. Recording the submissions made by the learned counsel for the second respondent, this Civil Revision Petition is dismissed. No costs.

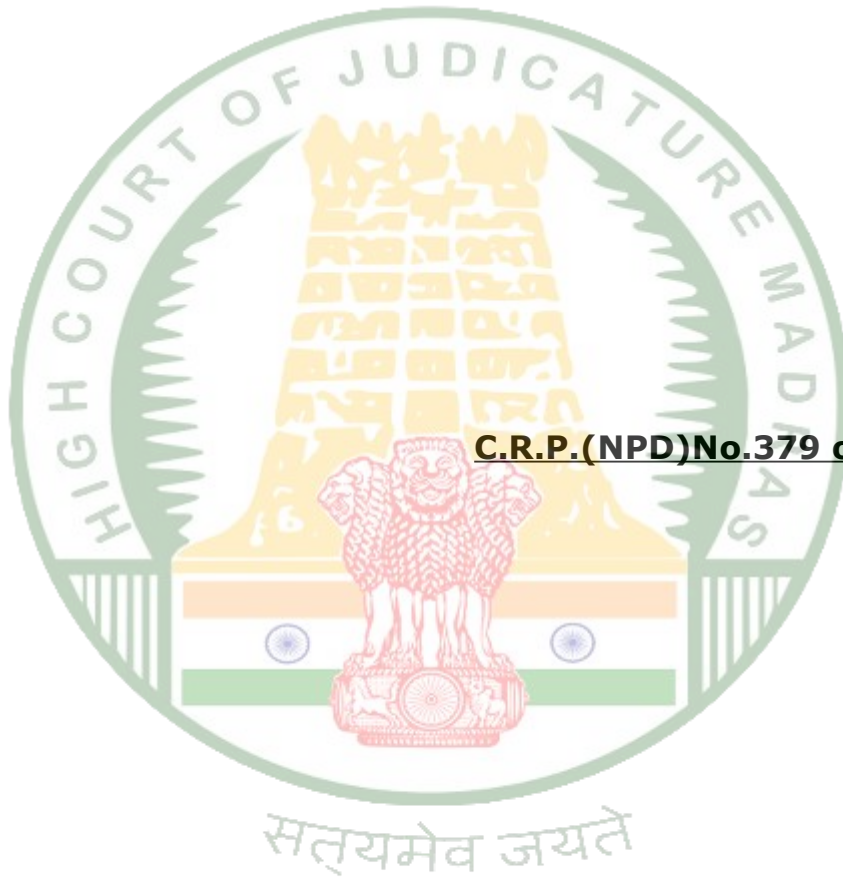
