at No.272/1, Kamaraj Street, Kakkanji Colony, Vysarpadi, Chennai - 39 and quash the same.

2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has represented that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked, by virtue of G.O.Rt.No.2799 dated 14.06.2017 and a copy of the same is submitted, wherein, it is clearly stated that the Detention Order in question has already been revoked.
