2.On notice issued to the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, instructions have been obtained and today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, he has produced the proceedings of the Chief Conservator of Forests and Director, Arignar Anna Zoological Park, Vandalur, dated 29.07.2017, in and by which, it appears that the direction passed by this Court has been complied with.

3.This Court has also gone through the proceedings and found that there has been compliance of the order passed by this Court. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner has some apprehension as to whether the said proceedings is in full compliance of the orders passed by this Court or not. In case, he has any serious doubts about the full compliance of the direction, it is not for him to pursue the course of contempt petition. It is always open to him to file a separate proceedings as he deems fit for any other relief which he claims to be entitled to.

the contempt petition is closed.
